



RIVALS CAMP SERIES: 2021 COVID GUIDELINES

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS AND SPECTATORS

- All attendees must sign our event waiver prior to attending the event.
- Do not enter the event if you, or anyone you live with, are exhibiting any signs of illness including sneezing, coughing, sniffles, fever, loss of taste or smell, or generally don't feel well.
- If event staff believes that a spectator or participant should not be admitted due to symptoms or results of a health screening, they will be asked to leave.
- Event staff reserves the right to remove any participants or spectators who do not comply with COVID Guidelines.
- Masks are to be worn by all staff, spectators and coaches at all times. Players must always wear
 masks unless actively participating in a drill or exercise. Players must wear masks when not
 competing.
- Temperature checks will be administered to all athletes, coaches and staff each day of the event.
- A wellness survey will be administered to all participants, coaches and staff prior to entry each day of the event.
- Concession areas are required to have 6ft between people waiting in line and all tables must be 6ft apart.
- Bathrooms also should abide by social distancing rules, which will require space between people waiting in lines.
- Athletes are asked to not congregate in the bleachers, or other common areas, while waiting for their turn to enter the field.
- Athletes must be registered for their designated session in order to participate. Athletes that are not registered, or who arrive for the wrong session, will not be admitted.
- There will be clear entries and exits at the facility and everyone must enter and exit from those designated areas.

SPECTATOR SEATING AND ADMISSION

- Spectators should wait in bleachers while athletes are on the field for the combine/camp.
 Spectators will not be permitted on the field at any time.
- While waiting in the bleachers, spectators are asked to maintain 6ft of social distance from other attendees/spectators.
- Spectators must leave the stadium when their athlete has completed the combine/camp.

EVENT PROTOCOL

- Athletes may only enter through designated areas within the facility- there will be prominent signage indicating where the exit/entry is located
- Participants must keep 6 feet apart when possible.

- All staff and volunteers are required to wear face coverings and gloves.
- Every time a player, staff member or volunteer switches stations they must sanitize their hands at designated hand sanitizing stations.
- Athletes are asked not to congregate around the field or in public areas when not participating in the combine.
- Athletes and spectators are asked to leave the field immediately after testing is completed
- Players and coaches are asked to refrain from high fives or any other physical gestures of celebration.
- All stations will be separated by at least 6 feet of space.
- When possible, space for 6 feet of social distancing will be allocated for athletes in each group.

EQUIPMENT

- You are to use the provided hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes before, during and after each station, and whenever appropriate, such as if/when coming into contact with other players, staff, volunteers or shared equipment.
- Refrain from sharing equipment in general.
- Staff will disinfect footballs (when applicable) before, during and after drills/session, when possible.
- Staff will be disinfecting all station equipment between each group session.
- Staff will sanitize check in stations and equipment in between each group session.
- All staff handling testing cards will wear gloves. Athletes must handle their own testing cards for the entirety of the event.
- All players should bring a personal water bottle with their name on it to use during the event. Communal coolers of water/Gatorade will not be provided.
